Parish Assembly renewal

There's been a lot going on in our parish and in the familyy of parishes since the nominations were done for the next parish assembly. All the nominations have now been collated. Those nominated will soon receive a letter inviting them to come to an information meeting where everyone will learn more about what's involved.

At that meeting, people will be invited to commit to serving on the parish assembly for the following three years.
